Right now I have all three of my floor looms dressed and going. I hate having an empty loom, it just sits there calling to me to do something with it. My problem is that sometimes I end up with a project on a loom that I just do not enjoy weaving. Right now my big loom in the basement has one of those tedious projects on it. I hate to admit how long it has been on there. On Saturday I decided to use my extra "fall break" hour weaving on that loom. I made some good progress and have not been back since. Part of the problem is that it is in the basement and my basement is just a basement. Concrete walls, rafters and lots of stuff stacked around. I have tried to make it as pleasant as possible. ## January Workshop

### "Three Shaft Weaves: When Less is Moore" by Joanne Batchelder

"Three Shaft Weaves: When Less is More" is about understanding interlacement on three shafts and how might incorporate this knowledge into our own work. We will back to 'square one' and examine 'known structures' by look at drafts and weaving samples. Understanding interlacement this basic level provides a foundation on which we can build. Then with this knowledge, altering and/or combining structure or even adding shafts, will make our work uniquely our own. Participants will be weaving on their own loom.

JoAnne weaves, researches textiles and teaches from her Rivertown Textiles studio, in Bay City, Michigan. She produces functional items and wall work for exhibitions and commissions. The manipulation of interlacements into new configurations gives her great pleasure and she enjoys integrating the surface with the image and idea.
